To the Sheriff of Franklin County, Greeting:

YOU are hereby commanded to take Henry Gullion if he be found in your bailiwick, and him safely keep so that you have his body before the Judges of our Franklin district court, at the court-house in Frankfort, on the third day of our next April court, to answer Alexander

Margregor of a Plea of Covenant broken Damage one hundred and Twenty Pounds

And have then there this writ. Witness WILLIS LEE, clerk of our said court at the court-house aforesaid, this 5th day of March 1799 and in the Seventh year of the commonwealth.

Know all men by these presents that we Henry Gullion James Reburn and Elisha Lindsay are held and firmly bound unto Nat. Richardson of Franklin County in the just and full sum of two hundred and forty pounds which payment well and truly to be made we bind our selves our heirs &c jointly severally and firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 5th day of March 1799

The condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas there did issue out the 5th day of March 1799 from the Office of the Clerk of the Court of the Franklin District a capias ad respondendum Alexander Margregor vs Henry Gullion for a Plea of Covenant broken damage one hundred and twenty pounds returnable to the third day of the April Term of said Court. Which capias as was this day executed by Allen Richardson upon Henry Gullion. Now if he the s^d Gullion do well and truly appear agreeable to the requisition of s^d Writ then the above Obligation to be void else to remain in full force power & virtue
