THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY,

To the Sheriff of Franklin County, Greeting:

YOU are hereby commanded to take *Henry Gullion* if he be found in your bailiwick, and safely keep so that you have his body before the Judges of our Franklin district court, at the court-house in Frankfort, on the *third* day of our next *April* court, to answer *Alexander Macgregor*

of a Plea of Covenant broken Damage One hundred and Twenty Dollars

And have then there this writ. Witness WILLIS LEE, clerk of our said court at the court-house aforesaid, this *5th* day of *March* 1799 and in the *Seventh* year of the commonwealth.

Know all men by these presents that we *Henry Gullion James Reyburn* and *Elisha Lindsey* are held and firmly bound unto *Wm. Richardson* Clerk of *Franklin County* in the full and full sum of two hundred and forty pounds which payment well and truly to be made we bind our selves our heirs &c jointly severally and firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this *5th* day of *March* 1799

The condition of the above Obligation is such that, who ever there did issue out the *5th* day of *March* 1799 from the Office of the Clerk of the Court of the *Franklin District* a *Capias* ad respondendum *Alexander Macgregor* vs *Henry Gullion* for a Plea of *Covenant broken* damage *one hundred and twenty pounds* returnable to the *third* day of the *April Term* of said Court. Which *Capias* as was this day executed by *Allen Richardson* upon *Henry Gullion*. Now if he the *s^d* *Gullion* do well and truly appear agreeable to the Requisition of *s^d* *Writ* then the above Obligation to be void else to remain in full force power & virtue
