The Last Will And Testament of Robert Gullion deceased

Be it remembered that on the 6th day of August, in, 1853, the last Will and Testament of Robert Gullion was produced into the office of the Clerk of the Switzerland Court of Common Pleas of S Switzerland County Indiana, and duly proved and admitted to Probate. Which Will and proof thereof read in the words and fig begins following to wit:

I Robert Gullion of Switzerland County in the State of Indiana, do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking and making void all former wills by me heretofore made.

~~First I direct that my body be decently interred and that my funeral be Conducted in a manner Coorsponding with my situation situation in life; as to such worldly property as it has pleased God to entrust one with. I dispene of the same in the following manner to wit:~~

I direct first that all my Just debts and funeral Expenses be paid as soon after my deceased as possible out of the first money that comes to the hands of my executors from any portion of my property:

I give and bequeath to Catherine Miller One hundred and twenty five dollars,

I give and bequeath to Sarah McQuiston One hundred and twenty five dollars,

I give and bequeath to Polly Miller One hundred and twenty five dollars.

I give and bequeath to Rachel Fulton One hundred and twenty five dollars.

I give and bequeath to Rachel ^{of Hume} Gullion twenty dollars.

I give and bequeath to my grandson John Gullion ten dollars.

There must be seventeen Dollars, and a half deducted out of each of the one hundred and twenty five dollars as I had paid each of the girls seventeen dollars and a half in times gone by heretofore.

And further It is my will that all my personal property after my death, that a fair valuation thereof shall be made by the appraisors and all equal divison made among the three boys. That is John Gullion, Henry and Charles, when I say personal property, I mean my household and Kitchen Furniture. I hereby make and ordain my sons John Gullion and Henry Gullion and also Charles Gullion exectors of this my last will and testament:
