

Gullion Research Notes of Kathryn Saylor

- Flora Smith who married Dalton Garrett had Dalton Garrett Jr.
- Susannah Webster who married Jesse Smith was a sister of Smith Webster and John Webster who married Rachel Gullion and Benjamin Webster who married Mary Gullion
- Melvina Hunt was born 1885. According to Kathryn she is buried in English
- Stanley Smith son of Wesley was born 1909 and died 1931 and is buried in English. KY Death Index he 2/4/1931 in Jefferson Co., KY
- According to Kathryn's notes, Rachel, brother of George P. Gullion, Sr., never married but had a daughter Rebecca who also never married. Rebecca's estates went to her uncle George P.
- Eliz Tingle, daughter of Kindall Tingle, married Jacob White on 2/28/1834 in Henry Co., KY
- Sophia Gullion married Daniel White in Henry Co., KY on 3/29/1850
- James Gullion [Sr.] died between 1820 and 1830. He was in the 1820 Census. The 1830 Census showed Sarah without James.
- A copy of the Carroll County, KY will of Rebecca Gullion is in Ms. Saylor's notes but it is too small to read. It mentions John S. Gullion, Susan P. Gullion, W. E. Nash, Lucy Gowings, Emma Gullion, M. Gullion, W. Gullion, E. White and Otis Bates. It is recorded in 1879 on page 610. I cannot make out the book number.
- Mary Adelaide Donaldson Gullion, wife of George P. Gullion, was the daughter of Allen Donaldson of Petersburg and Amanda Foster of Cincinnati, OH
- Nancy Rainey, wife of Curtis Monroe Gullion, had sisters: Mrs. Thomas Deatherage and Mrs. Lawrence Hanson, and a brother John Rainey. She had a son who died 1/27/1903.
