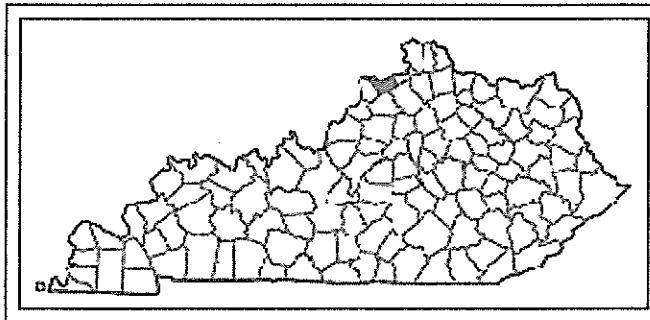

Wm.(Bill)  
Jones. one other child not named.

Benjamin Webster born, October 21, 1867, md to Nannie  
McDole.

Lotta Ann Webster born March 3, 1870, died 1931, md to  
Alexander (Alec)  
MCDole.

William (Bill) Webster born March 30, 1873, died November 29,  
1903,  
never married, 30 years old.

James Maddison (Matt) Webster bron December, 1875 md to  
Esyabell McDole

Twin daughters,  
Lenora Webster, born May 9, 1878, died at birth.  
Victoria born May 9, 1878, died 11 November, 1898.

Notes:

John Webster's father was John Webster who died on Mill Creek  
ca 1852,  
obit, Carrollton newspaper. His mother was said to be Nancy  
Yowl, but no  
proof.  
Rachel Gullion Webster was the daughter of Sarah Moore and  
James Gullion.  
William Webster, Lenora, Victoria . Sarah Jane and Nancy Ellen  
Webster  
Harper along with their parents, John Webster and Rachel  
Gullion Webster  
are buried on top of the Gilgal Hill on what is now the land of  
Robert

Kendall. It is known as the Coleman Cemetery.
